# Amarillo Hat & Mitts

## Skill Level

Intermediate

## Finished Size

Adult Small (Medium, Large)

Hat Circumference (relaxed):

16½ (18, 19½)" [42 (46, 50)cm]


To Fit Circumference:

19 (21, 23)" [48 (53, 58)cm]

Mitts to Fit Hand Circumference:

6½ (7, 7½)" [16.5 (17.8, 19.1)cm]

## Materials

- Willow Yarns™ Paint Brush   
(75% wool/25% nylon; 100g/459yd)  
-730096-0007 Blue Flower (1 ball)
- US size 4 (3.5mm) 16" circular needle  
or size needed to obtain gauge
- US size 4 (3.5mm) dpn or size needed  
to obtain gauge
- US size 2 (2.75mm) dpn
- Stitch markers
- Waste yarn
- Yarn needle

## Gauge

27 sts x 38 rows = 4" (10.2cm) in 1x1  
ribbing, lightly stretched with size 4 needle  
*Save time, check your gauge.*

## Pattern Note

- If ends are woven in carefully, this hat  
is reversible with a different look on  
each side.

## Instructions

### Hat

With size 4 dpn and waste yarn, CO 12 sts.

Change to main yarn, pm, and join to work in  
the rnd.

**Note:** When you have enough sts, change to a  
circular needle.

**Rnd 1:** K.

**Rnd 2:** (Kfb, p1) around—18 sts.

**Rnd 3:** (Kfb, k2) around—24 sts.

**Rnd 4:** (Kfb, p1, k1, p1) around—30 sts.

**Rnd 5:** \*Kfb, k4, pm; rep from \* around—36 sts.

**Rnd 6:** \*Kfb, (p1, k1) twice, p1, sl m; rep from \*  
around—42 sts.

**Rnd 7:** \*Kfb, k6, sl m; rep from \* around—48 sts.

**Rnd 8:** \*Kfb, (p1, k1) 3 times, p1, sl m; rep from \*  
around—54 sts.

**Rnd 9:** \*Kfb, k8, sl m; rep from \* around—60 sts.

**Rnd 10:** \*Kfb, (p1, k1) 4 times, p1, sl m; rep from  
\* around—66 sts.

**Rnd 11:** \*Kfb, k10, sl m; rep from \* around—72 sts.

**Rnd 12:** \*Kfb, (p1, k1) 5 times, p1, sl m; rep from  
\* around—78 sts.

**Rnd 13:** K.

**Rnd 14:** \*Kfb, (k1, p1) to next m, sl m; rep from \*  
around—6 sts inc'd.

**Rnd 15:** K.

**Rnd 16:** \*Kfb, p1, (k1, p1) to next m, sl m; rep  
from \* around—6 sts inc'd.

Rep last 4 rnds 1 (2, 3) more times—102 (114,  
126) sts

Rep Rnds 13-14 once more—108 (120, 132) sts.

### Body of Hat

**Rnd 1:** K.

**Rnd 2:** \*K1, p1; rep from \* around.

Rep last 2 rnds until hat measures 7 (7½, 8)"  
[17.8 (19.1, 20.3)cm].

### Brim

**Rnd 1:** \*K1, p1; rep from \* around.

Rep last rnd for 2¾" (7cm).

BO all sts in pat.

### Mitts

#### Cuff

With size 2 dpn, CO 36 (40, 44) sts. Pm and join to  
work in the rnd, being careful not to twist work.

**Rnd 1:** \*K1, p1; rep from \* around.

Rep Rnd 1 until mitt measures 1" (2.5cm).

#### Hand

**Rnd 1:** K around.

**Rnd 2:** \*K1, p1; rep from \* around.

Rep last 2 rnds until mitt measures 4¾" (12.1cm),  
ending with Rnd 2.

#### Thumb

**Transition Rnd:** K to last 2 sts, ssk—35 (39, 43)  
sts. Turn and beg to work back and forth in rows.

**Row 1 (WS):** Sl 1 wyif, \*k1, p1; rep from \* across.

**Row 2 (RS):** Sl 1 wyib, k to end.

Rep last 2 rows until thumb opening measures  
2½" (6.4cm), ending with a RS row.

CO 1 st and join to work in the rnd—36 (40, 44) sts.

#### Top of Hand

**Rnd 1:** \*K1, p1; rep from \* around.

**Rnd 2:** K around.

Rep last 2 rnds twice more.

Rep Rnd 1 six more times.

BO all sts in pat.

#### Finishing

Use CO end to close top of hat.

Weave in ends.

## ABBREVIATIONS

**beg:** begin/beginning

**BO:** bind off

**cm:** centimeter

**CO:** cast on

**dpn:** double pointed needles

**inc'd:** increased

**k:** knit

**kfb:** knit in the front and back of  
next stitch—1 stitch increased

**m:** marker

**p:** purl

**pat:** pattern

**pm:** place marker

**rep:** repeat/repeats

**rnd/rnds:** round/rounds

**RS:** right side

**sl:** slip

**ssk:** slip, slip, knit these 2 stitches  
together—1 stitch decreased

**st/sts:** stitch/stitches

**WS:** wrong side

**wyib:** with yarn in back

**wyif:** with yarn in front
